Princeton Show Jumping Regulations:

ENTRIES CLOSE: June 11, 2010

ENTRIES MAY BE LIMITED BY POST MARK DATE!

STALL & ENTRIES WILL NOT BE CONFIRMED WITHOUT PAYMENT. Stall fees and nominating fees must be paid with each entry. Non-nominated divisions must send a \$100 deposit per horse. The nominating fee and or horse deposit ensures your horse's space in the show and is non-refundable after the closing date. Substitutions will be accepted. Any entry made without stall, nomination or deposit payment will be considered post entries. Open checks sent will be filled in for these amounts.

POST ENTRIES: Accepted on a space available basis. \$50 per horse

Additions & Substitutions to entered accounts will be accepted after the show start at no fee. Totally new stable/farm/trainer entries are \$50. additional once the show starts space available.)

LATE STALLS: If Late stalls are available, \$50. Additional

DECLARATIONS: Please declare for all classes by 5 PM the night before the class. Ship-ins please call (609) 924-2932 to declare with the secretary.

POSTED ORDER: **One of the hallmarks of our show is the posted order.** This is a one-ring horse show without conflicts. To be fair to ALL COMPETITORS we will start on time and stick to the posted order. In non-Classics trainer groupings should be requested the night before. There will be a posted order. Please do not arrive at 8 AM for the first class and ask, "When can I go." Orders will be available at 7:00 pm the night before. Course walk will end at 7:50 AM.

GRAND PRIX HORSES MUST BE STABLED ON THE GROUNDS AS PER USEF REGULATIONS BY 12 Noon Saturday each Week. Check in horse, number, & stall location with the Steward by Noon. Riding and schooling only in the dedicated schooling area til 7pm on Saturday. Not before 6am on Sunday.

UNLEASHED DOGS: Are not allowed (\$100 USET Foundation donation)

The steward and/or the committee will eliminate an entry on the first offense. *Riders are fully responsible for what they jump in the practice arena.* Honor system please. Show committee members may rule on any violation or rule interpretation to insure the fairness of competition.

ALL RIDERS MUST WEAR ASTM APPROVED HEADGEAR WHEN MOUNTED.

THE COMMITTEE, ANDREW H. PHILBRICK, HUNTER FARMS' MANAGEMENT AND STAFF WILL NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ACCIDENT, LOSS, DAMAGE OR INJURY OCCURING AT THE SHOW. (Please read entry blank)

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT:

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

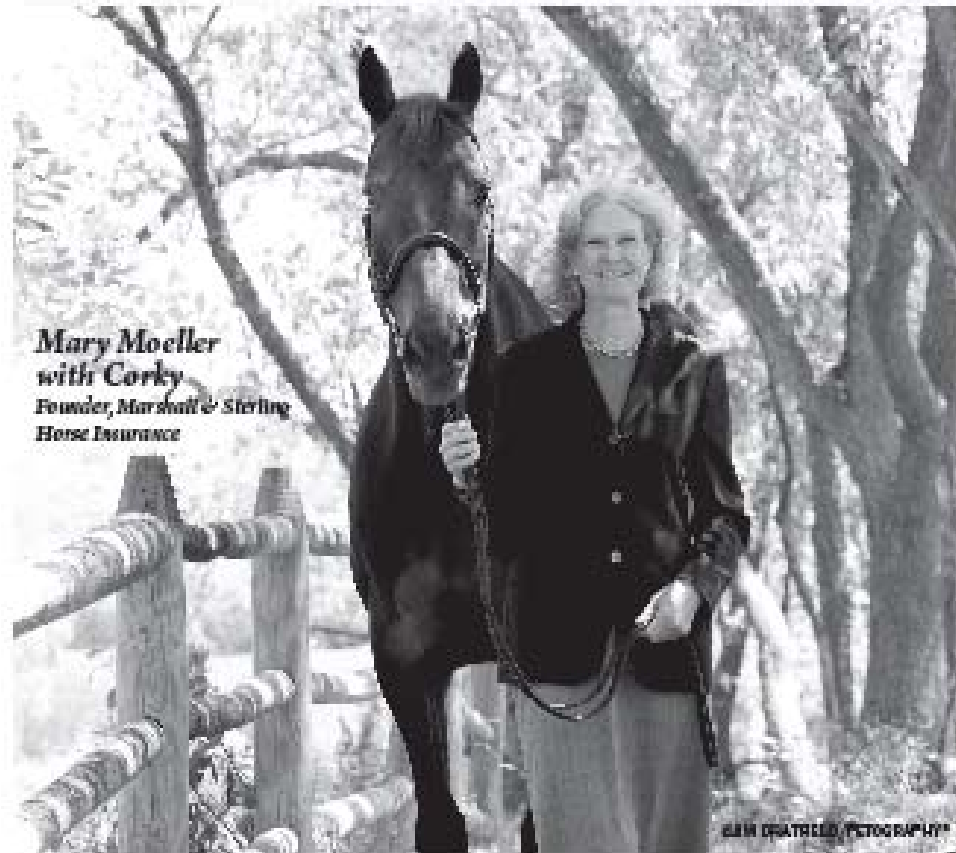

USEF/Princeton Show Jumping Rules & Regulations:

1. The right is reserved to cancel, combine or divide any classes if entries so warrant.
In addition, the right is reserved to refuse any entry before the start of the competition with out being liable for compensation.
2. Prize money will be applied to the exhibitor's outstanding account if any, or mailed to the exhibitor as listed on the entry blank within 30 days of the close of the show. Checks void after 60 days. The Horse Show will not stop payment or duplicate awards for any lost check.
3. Refunds: No refunds on stalls after the closing date. If a horse becomes injured or ill prior to being shown in any class, entry fees will be refunded upon receipt of a Veterinarian's certificate. An office-processing fee of \$35 per legitimately excused animal will be deducted from the refund. All certificates, to be considered, must be received by show management before the closing of the show.
4. Course diagrams will be posted at least one hour prior to each class. Indoor warm up ring 90' x 200' Travel Lite footing. Show ring 175' x 300' with all weather footing.
5. Temporary stabling of canvas construction with doors available at \$200 per stall. No initial bedding provided. No wiring of any kind allowed in the stabling areas. Closing date to reserve stalls is June 11, 2010. A charge of \$250 per stall, if available, for stalls reserved after the closing date.
6. Riders must be properly attired for all classes. **Jackets** are required in all classes unless waived due to inclement weather. Protective headgear is required at all times when mounted on the show grounds. It must meet or exceed ASTM standards for equestrian use, carry the SEI tag, and be properly fitted with harness secured.
7. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have CURRENT MEMBERSHIPS for any and all classes, which require the same.
8. ENTRIES CLOSE June 11, 2010 for both shows. All entry and stall fees must be paid by the closing date of entries. No entry will be considered valid unless accompanied by full payment or open check. Mail entries to Hunter Farms, 1315 The Great Rd Princeton NJ 08540 FAXED ENTRIES 609-921-3435 will only be processed upon receipt of a check.
9. The right is reserved to limit the number of entries accepted in any and all divisions. If entries must be limited, they will be selected on a first come, first served basis, selected by postmark date. Post entries will be accepted at \$50 per horse, only if time permits. Entries made the day of the show by totally new accounts, will be accepted at an additional fee of \$50 per horse, only if time permits.
10. Numbers will not be issued until a signed, open check is lodged with the horse show secretary and all USEF membership cards, and measurement cards have been seen & verified.
11. Entries must add & scratch classes prior to the beginning of the class with the show secretary. Scratch fee of \$0 per class. Horses shown in a class with out being entered will pay double the class entry fee.
12. Jumper Nomination Fee is \$150.
13. \$100 charge for non-competing horses
14. An office fee of \$35 will be charged
15. A fee of \$250 will be charged to exhibitor's account for any returned check.
16. Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in these rules, the same shall be referred to show management whose decision shall be final.
17. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. (GR1301.7)
18. Breaking ties for other than first place will be done by time taken in the first round.
19. Classes with \$1,500 or more in prize money need 15 to fill. Otherwise 100% Sweepstakes of Entry Fees 30%, 20%, 15% 10%, 10%, 10%, 5%

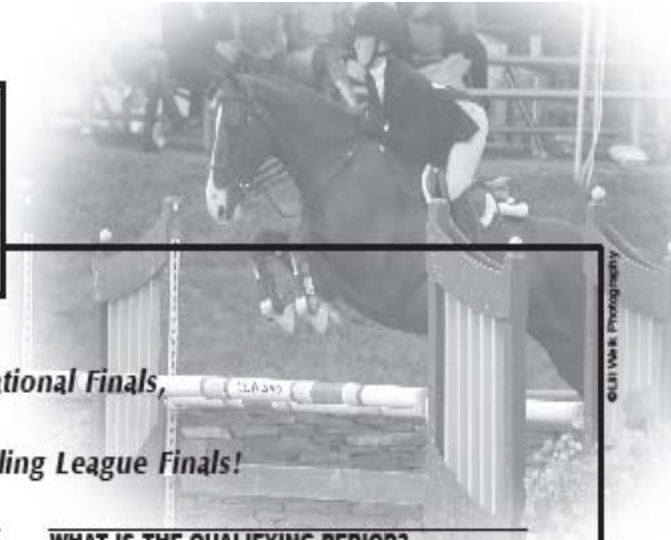

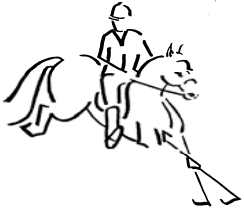
